# Call to drop ethnic link

MONASH councillors have called for the ethnic identities of soccer clubs to be stripped after an ugly repeat of spectator violence at an Oakleigh Cannons-Preston Lions match last month.

Up to 20 spectators were involved in a brawl outside the Cheltenham RSL Club, soon after the game at Kingston Heath ground on August 26.

Police arrested two spectators after hurled rocks and missiles caused damage to several cars.

The episode follows a larger brawl between 60 spectators from the two clubs at Jack Edwards Reserve in 2005.
